This year, the Appeal starts with an update on projects previously funded. Your generosity works, and we thought you would like to hear about it!

At this year's November Board Meeting, the design of the commemorative plaque to be placed in the recently completed Memorial Garden at the Jericho Historical Center was unanimously approved. The plaque was funded by donations to the Annual Appeal. The creation of the garden was also made possible through previous donations.

The angled plaque, mounted on a pedestal for easy reading will be divided into quadrants, each with a QR code linked to the story about the connection between the person honored and either the history of the Town of Dennis or the Dennis Historical Society. Two of the four to be honored are Elizabeth Reynard and Virginia Gildersleeve who donated the Captain Baker House and Barn to the Town of Dennis. The two others, Kathy Roche and Natalie Chase are being honored for their very significant bequests to the DHS.
